Youth Employment Pathway Program

The Flagstaff Group and Greenacres in the Shoalhaven region are seeking to prepare, train and trial potential disability support workers across community and/or employment settings. In collaboration with the Wesley Vocational Institute, vocational training and work placement are being offered to a group of eligible, suitable and genuinely interested young people aged between 18 and 24 years looking for a career opportunity in the disability field.

To be eligible for this program:

- Applicants must be between ages 18 and 24
- They preferably should possess a minimum P1 Provisional Drivers License
- They will need to obtain a Working with Children Check and Police Check
- Applicants must be genuinely caring and empathic with a willingness to empower people with a disability
- They will need to travel to various locations in the Shoalhaven for training and employment.
